EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 13-2021

“AN ORDER IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES TO BE OBSERVED UNDER THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE STATUS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SANTA ANA, CAGAYAN.”

WHEREAS, the IATF issued the Omnibus Guidelines on the implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with amendments as of March 28, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Province of Cagayan and Region II Provinces except Batanes was declared under General Community Quarantine Status due to the continuing rise of COVID-19 cases;

WHEREAS, The Local IATF of Santa Ana, Cagayan convened and decided on the guidelines and protocols to be observed, consistent to the Omnibus Guidelines issued by the National IATF;

NOW THEREFORE, I NELSON P. ROBINION, Municipal Mayor of Santa Ana, Cagayan, by virtue of the power vested in my by law, do hereby order:

SECTION I – THE MUNICIPALITY OF SANTA ANA UNDER THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE SHALL BE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING PROTOCOLS;

1). Minimum public health standards shall be complied with at all times for the duration of General Community Quarantine period.

2). Movement of all persons shall be limited to accessing essential goods and services, and for work offices or industries permitted to operate hereunder, provided, that movement for leisure purposes shall not be allowed.

3). Any person below 15 years old, or those above 65 years of age, and those with immunodeficiency, or other health risks and pregnant women, including any person who resides with the aforementioned, shall be required to remain in their residences at all times, except when indispensable under the circumstances for obtaining essential goods and services or for work in permitted industries and offices.

4). LGU Offices shall be in full operational capacity and employees are required to report physically and strictly observing the health protocols.

5). Accredited diplomatic missions and international organizations may operate at fifty percent (50%) capacity.

6). Only those activities and establishments mentioned in Section 4 (2) of the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines as amended on 28 March 2021 issued by IATF are allowed to operate at an operational capacity provided in the DTI implementing guidelines.

7). Limited operations in shopping establishments shall be allowed except for Leisure Establishments and Services which shall continue to be closed.





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8). All public and private construction projects shall be allowed, but with the construction safety guidelines issued by DPWH for the implementation of infrastructure projects during the COVID-19 pandemic.

9). Amusement, gaming, and fitness establishments, as well as those in the kids and tourism industries may not operate. Their compliance shall be assessed in accordance with the protocols of the concerned agencies led by DTI, DOH and LGU Health Office.

10). Only **HOTELS** or accommodation Establishments with VALID DOT Accreditation shall be allowed to accommodate guests/clients for legitimate purposes under a state of Public Health Emergency. Operations of such hotel and accommodation establishments, as well as ancillary establishments within their premises like restaurants/cafes/spas/function halls, etc . shall be subject to DOT/IATF guidelines.

11). Face-to-face or in-person classes shall be suspended. The Dep-Ed Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan shall be adopted and observed accordingly.

12). Mass gatherings shall be prohibited. Gatherings that are for the provision of critical government services and authorized humanitarian activities shall be allowed, provided, prescribed minimum health standards be strictly observed.

Religious gatherings shall be allowed up to fifty percent (50%) of the seating capacity, provided, that such religious gathering shall be limited to the conduct of religious worship/service. Provided further, that they should strictly observe the minimum public health standards, to wit:

- a) Social distancing
- b) Obligatory wearing of face masks
- c) Immediate availability of hand hygiene necessities within the premises

13). Non-contact sports and other forms of exercise (walking, jogging, running, biking, swimming, tennis, badminton, diving, etc) are allowed provided, minimum health standards and, no sharing of equipment where applicable, are observed.

14). The public transportation sector shall be allowed, subject to the guidelines issued by the DOT.

15). Visits to open-air memorial parks and cemeteries shall be limited to not more than ten (10) persons per group. The number of groups at any given time shall be at the discretion of the management, taking into consideration, the observance of public health standards.

SECTION II – INTER ZONAL AND INTRA ZONAL MOVEMENT

1). The movement of all types of cargoes by land, air or sea within and across areas or places under any form of community quarantine shall be UNHAMPERED.





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The PNP has the authority to conduct inspection procedures in the checkpoints for the purpose of ensuring observance of protocols.

2). Authorized Persons Outside their Residence (APOR) shall be permitted:

- a) health and emergency frontline services personnel
- b) government officials/government frontline personnel
- c) duly-authorized humanitarian assistance actors (HAA)
- d) persons travelling for medical or humanitarian reasons
- e) persons going to airport for travel abroad
- f) anyone crossing for work or business permitted in the zone of destination, and going back home.
- g) also considered APORS are 1). Returning OFWs to their places of residence 2) other persons transported by the national government upon observance of necessary protocols, and acceptance/concurrence of LGU concerned.
- h) government officials/personnel/employees with corresponding travel authority and HAAs transporting medical supplies and laboratory equipments and/or other relief and humanitarian assistance shall be allowed, whether by air, land or sea travel.

SECTION III – OTHER GENERAL PROVISIONS

1). CURFEW HOURS shall be imposed from 10:00PM to 5:00AM.

2). Acts of discrimination inflicted upon health care workers, COVID-19 cases, PUMs, PUIs shall be dealt with civilly/administratively, pending enactment of an ordinance penalizing these discriminatory acts.

SECTION IV – SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any part, or provision of these GUIDELINES is held unconstitutional or invalid, other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION V – EFFECTIVITY

These Guidelines shall take effect immediately and remain in force until a new guideline be issued, or upon declaration of a new community quarantine status of the municipality.
