EXECUTIVE ORDER N O. 42 Series of 2021

"AN ORDER IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES ON ALERT LEVEL 2 FOR COVID-19 WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SANTA ANA, CAGAYAN"

WHEREAS, The President issued E.O. No. 151, s. 2021 ON November 11, 2021, approving the nationwide implementation of Alert Level System for COVID-19 Response;

WHEREAS, the Province of Cagayan and this Municipality was placed under Alert Level System 2, pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 148-F date November 3, 2021;

WHEREAS, in conformity to the advocacy on the 3Cs (Closed, Crowded, Close-Contact) strategy against COVID-19, it is mandatory to adopt the guidelines inorder to curb the spread of infection among our constituents;

NOW THEREFORE, I, NELSON P. ROBINION, MUNICIPAL MAYOR OF SANTA ANA, CAGAYAN, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION I – DEFINITION OF TERMS

For purposes of Clarity, the following shall be defined as follows:

COVID-19 Alert Level System – refers to the new Community Quarantine Classifications for dealing COVID-19 covering entire cities, municipalities, provinces and regions aimed to manage and minimize the risk of the disease through System Indicators. Triggers and Thresholds determined by the IATF to specify the public health and social measures to be taken in relation to the COVID-19 response as may be updated based on new scientific knowledge, information about the effectiveness of control measures in the country and overseas, and its application.

- a) Alert Level 1 refers to areas wherein case transmission is low and decreasing, total bed utilization rate, and intensive case unit utilization rate is low.
- b) Alert Level 2 refers to areas wherein case transmission is low and decreasing, healthcare utilization is low, or case counts are low but increasing, or case counts are low and decreasing, but bed utilization rate and intensive care utilization rate is increasing.
- c) Alert Level 3 refers to areas wherein case counts are high and/or increasing, with total bed utilization rate and intensive care unit utilization rate at increasing utilization.
- d) Alert Level 4 refers to areas wherein case counts are high and/or increasing with total bed utilization rate and intensive rate unit utilization rate at high utilization.
- e) Alert Level 5 refers to areas wherein case counts are alarming with total bed utilization rate and intensive care unit utilization rate at critical utilization.

GRANULAR LOCKDOWN – refers to a micro-level quarantine for areas identified "critical zones" by the LGU which may be declared regardless of Alert Level.

MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS (MPS) – refers to the national, local and sector – specific guidelines on mitigation measures for its COVID-19 response across all settings





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by implementing non-pharmaceutical interventions, consistent with DOH Administration Order or the Omnibus Guidelines on MPHS for the safe reopening of Institutions. This term encompasses non-pharmaceutical Interventions (NPI) of community mitigation strategies/public health measures that do not involves vaccines, medications or other pharmaceutical interventions, the persons and communities must carry out in order to reduce transmission rates, contact rates and the duration of infectiousness of persons in the population.

SECTION II - Guidelines on Alert Level 2

The Municipality of Santa Ana, Cagayan shall adopt the following protocols:

- 1) Intrazonal and interzonal movement shall be allowed. However, reasonable restrictions shall be imposed by this LGU subject to the evaluation, monitoring and oversight of the local IATF of Santa Ana, Cagayan.
- 2). Dine-in business, personal care services, entertainment and recreational venues, mass gatherings, funeral services, meetings, incentives, conferences, exhibits, and indoor tourist attractions are permitted to operate at a maximum of 50% capacity. Those with Safety Seal Certifications will be allowed to operate an additional 10% beyond the prescribed capacity.
- 3). Outdoor exercise are allowed. Close contact sports activities are allowed, provided, all participants are fully vaccinated.
- 4). Casinos, horse racing cock fighting and operation of cockpits, lottery and betting shops, and other gaming establishments shall <u>not</u> be allowed to operate, or be undertaken, except, authorized by IATF or the Office of the President.
- 5). The following establishments/activities shall be allowed to operate or be undertaken at a Maximum 50% indoor venue capacity for FULLY VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS and 70% outdoor venue capacity. Provided, that all workers/employees of these establishments are fully vaccinated against COVI-19, and Minimum Public Health Standards shall be strictly maintained, to wit:

Venue for meeting, incentives, conferences and exhibitions venues for social events & tourist destinations accredited by DOT.

Accommodation establishments must coordinate with the archway entrance regarding reservation of guests prior to entry. Only fully vaccinated tourists/travelers shall be allowed, otherwise, they will undergo Antigen Tests before entering Santa Ana.

Face-to-face or in-person classes shall be allowed subject to Dep-Ed guidelines.

Dine-in Services of foods establishments shall be subject to DTI Protocols.

Transport groups (buses & vans) shall be allowed subject to DOTr Guidelines and Protocols. In all instances, only fully vaccinated individuals shall be allowed at 50% capacity of the transport facility. Crews/employees of transport vehicles shall be fully vaccinated.





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In person religious gatherings, wakes, necrological services, funerals and internment for those who died of causes other than COVID-19 are allowed subject to strict observance of health protocols.

Government agencies and instrumentalities shall remain in full operation in these areas and must implement an on-site working capacity of at least 50% mixed with work-from-home arrangements.

SECTION III - EFFECTIVITY

THIS ORDER takes effect immediately until Alert Level 2 is in full force in the Province of Cagayan, or a new order shall be issued.
